

Meeting minutes of 1st Sahodhya meeting

Date: 27th June 2026

Venue: Indore Public School, Rajendra Nagar

Time: 3:00 PM

No. of Principals Present: 70

1. The meeting commenced at 3:20 PM with a melodious welcome song presented by the host school.
2. The Chairperson, Ms. Sudha Pandey, extended a warm welcome to all Principals and office bearers present.
3. She briefed the house about the work done by the new Committee after the declaration of the new core committee on 29th April
 - a) The ISSC website has been updated.
 - b) The list of all four clusters has been updated.
 - c) The annual calendar for Sahodaya competitions has been prepared.
4. The Chairperson requested all host schools to keep the arrangements for Sahodaya meetings simple and minimal, avoiding elaborate menus or multiple items.
5. She urged all member schools to actively participate in hosting and taking part in competitions to ensure the grand success of all Sahodaya events.
6. The Secretary, Ms. Geeta Taneja, presented the Minutes of the last Annual General Meeting held at Annie Besant School. The same were confirmed by the house. She also read out the latest CBSE circulars for information of all members.
7. The City Coordinator, Mr. Jha, was requested to elaborate on the R1, R2, R3 language circular. He explained the provisions of the circular in detail to the satisfaction of all members.
8. The Treasurer, Ms. Anamika Singh, proposed that the annual subscription for Sahodaya member schools would remain unchanged for this session, i.e., ₹5,000/- as in the previous year. During discussion, a few members suggested increasing the subscription to enable payment of remuneration to referees for various sports events. After deliberation, the Chairperson decided that the annual subscription would not be increased and would remain ₹5,000/- only.
9. The Vice Chairperson, Ms. Juhi Mishra, presented the draft annual calendar for Sahodaya competitions and invited suggestions from the house. After discussion, she informed that the final calendar, incorporating the suggested changes, would be shared shortly in the official group.
10. Mr. Mohit Yadav shared information regarding the IMC Water Mission for Rain Water Harvesting. He conveyed the appeal of Hon'ble Mayor Shri Pushymitra Bhargav to all school leaders to implement rain water harvesting systems in their institutions to help raise the groundwater level of Indore city.
11. Mr. Ansh Jain proposed organizing a MUN Democratic Summit this year for all Sahodaya Schools.
12. A suggestion was put forth to host a Capacity Building Workshop for educators under the aegis of Indore Sahodaya Schools Complex. The house appreciated the idea for professional development.

13. The meeting concluded on a positive note at 4:45 PM. Members appreciated that the meeting was conducted in a brief, to-the-point manner with timely commencement and conclusion. All members departed with a sense of satisfaction.
